Lunches, register and beginning to play

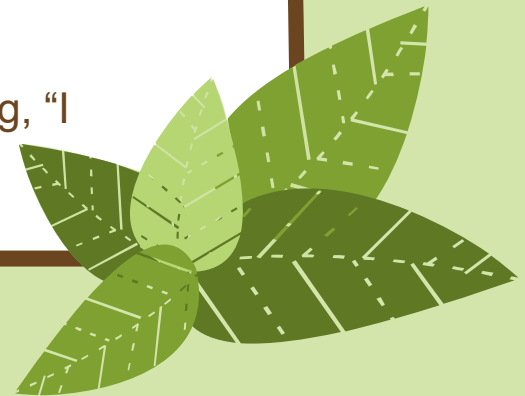

What are we learning?

Spelling

Joined phonemes and common words.

Reading

Reading aloud and comprehension (this term we are focussing on prior knowledge and inference).

Writing

Writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We are writing imaginative stories using adjectives to make our writing interesting.

Numeracy & Maths

2D and 3D shapes with Mrs Morley and we will explore symmetry, pattern and position & movement. With Miss Stobo we are currently working on place value, numbers to 20 and numbers to 100.

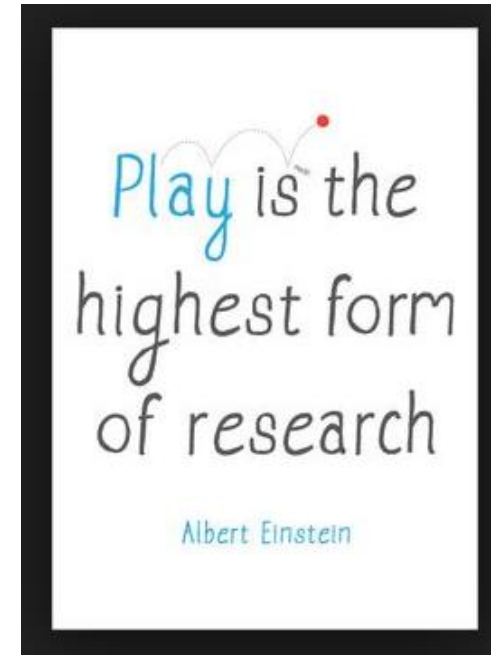
IDL

We are learning about how things grow including animals and plants. The children generated some "I wonder" questions around this topic that we aim to answer through our learning.

In P2 we are learning through play!

Play encourages learning through:

- Spontaneous play
- Planned, purposeful play
- Investigating and exploring
- Focussed learning and teaching
- Practising skills learned through formal teaching tasks



Homework

- Homework will be handed out on a Monday afternoon and collected on a Thursday morning. Please check bags and folders for all tasks and instructions.

Each week you can expect...

- a reading book to practise reading aloud with an adult/ teddy
- new phoneme, spelling words and common words to copy into jotters and task progression throughout the year
- a numeracy worksheet linked to our learning the previous week



Other homework ideas...

- Ask your child about their day
 - * what did you learn today?
 - * what did you do really well with?
 - * what do you think you need help with/ practise of?
- Letter and number formation
- Counting tasks, counting in 2s, 5s, 10s, forwards and backwards, starting at different numbers, etc.
- ICT games
- Practise writing your name, address and phone number
- Become more independent
 - * get dressed yourself
 - * brush your own teeth or hair
 - * do your zips and tie your shoe laces
 - * open your own snacks
 - * remember your manners

Other things to remember

Lunches

P1-5 children are entitled to free school meals. Make sure you discuss with your child what is for lunch that day.
